**Proposals MUST be submitted as one complete packet to include: (budget, maps, photos, etc.)**

Projects generally range between \$5,000 and \$20,000. Priority is given to those with matching funds, established partnerships, multi-species benefits, management relevance, highest wildlife impact, appropriate budgets, landscape scale, and with a lasting legacy of benefits. Proposals should address on the ground add-on projects, not traditional M&O funding needs, including salaries. Out-of-state projects may be submitted, but will be funded only if clear benefits to Wyoming's wildlife can be demonstrated.

Projects will be evaluated based on likelihood of success, project readiness, and availability of matching funds, multiple species benefits, significance at local/state/regional level, duration of benefits, and adequacy of monitoring.
